2. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Ingredients: Aqua, Tall Oil Acid, Polyurethane, Trideceth-6, Oleamide DEA, Titanium Dioxide, Sodium Hydroxide, Acrylates/Steareth-20 Methacrylate Copolymer, Tetrasodium EDTA, Methylidibromo Glutaronitrile, Phenoxyethanol, 2:4-dimethyl-6tertiary butyl phenol, Parfum, Glutaral.
